

Marion Community Unit #2 District
New Student Attendance Center Assignment Procedure
(Adopted: June 19, 2012)

Student resides within Marion Unit #2 Boundaries?

YES

Determine home school zone that student resides

Compare class size range at home school with other serving schools, if applicable. Grade 6-8 students will attend MJHS or Adams School. Grade 9-12 students will attend MHS

If range is equitable according to the Collective Bargaining Agreement, assign student(s) to home school.

Notify parent.

NO

Pay tuition & follow District's Attendance Center Assignment Procedure
or
Attend school district which student resides

If range is NOT equitable according to the Collective Bargaining Agreement, assign student(s) to closest & safest school route that District transportation is provided. .

Notify parent.

Guidelines

Students attending an attendance center that is currently not their own (e.g. Student living in another school's zone.) at the conclusion of the 2011-2012 school year will be allowed to continue attending that school until the child's grade level assignment determines a change of attendance center (e.g. Lincoln School 5th grader moves to MJHS)

Siblings will also be allowed to attend the same attendance center to avoid dual attendance centers; however, a sibling must attend their designated home school if they are the sole student from that family.

If a student moves from the home school boundaries or District boundaries, they will be considered a new student and must follow the Attendance Center Assignment Plan.

Request to change from an attendance center must follow District Attendance Center Change procedure.
